Eligibility

- Ages 6 and up. Underage hunters (<16 YOA) must be part of a two man team and directly supervised by an individual 21 YOA or older.
- **Applications submitted by individuals with past or current NOVAAs will be reviewed for eligibility.**

Applicants

- You may apply as an individual or as a 2 man team.
- Your name can only appear on one application either as a single hunter or as part of a two man team.
- Any applicant whose name appears on multiple applications will be removed from the lottery.

Application

1 Sept. until COB 30 Sept. 2021
 • **Application must be mailed or returned in person to the Natural Resources Office.**
 • Applications must be received by the NRO by COB on 30 Sept 2021. If you mail your application plan accordingly, the NRO will not accept mailed applications arriving after the due date.

DO NOT

E-mail or FAX

- Once submitted names on applications may not be altered.
- Incomplete or illegible applications will not be entered in the lottery.
- Applicants may not transfer their application.
- A drawing will randomly fill all 32 hunting slots for each hunt. Single hunters drawn will be paired with another single hunter to fill the zone.
- One-third of the applicants selected will be active duty (hunt applications for the active duty category can only have active duty partners). One-third of the applicants selected will be DOD (hunt applications for the DOD category can only have DOD or active duty partners). One-third of the applicants selected will be non-DOD affiliated civilians (hunt applications for the non-DOD affiliated civilian category can only have non-DOD affiliated civilians as a partner).

Drawing Notification

Applicants can view hunters selected for the hunt by checking Eglin:sportsman.net under the Special Opportunity Event tab, select the 7SFG(A) Archery Hunt from the drop down menu. Hunters selected will be identified by the following information provided from their application:

- Drawing results **will not** be given out over the phone. **Example:** 123456 / BM / 145
- 1) isportsman Account Number (if they have one)
 - 2) First initial of their first and last names
 - 3) Last three digits of their phone number

Confirm Acceptance 18 Oct 2021 by COB
 • Applicants selected in the lottery not confirming their slot by COB on the established date will forfeit their slot to the first available alternate.

Cost of Hunt \$50.00 per hunter

- Selected applicants can purchase their Special Opportunity Hunt Permit during the week of the hunt.
- A photo ID will be required to purchase your permit.
- Applicants claiming DOD status will have to provide proof when purchasing special Opportunity Hunt Permit.
- **Non-resident hunters selected will need to purchase a \$46.50 Florida 10 day non-resident hunting permit.**
- **A \$5 FWC deer permit is required for all hunt phases and a \$5 FWC archery permit is also required if drawn for Phase 1 hunt dates.**

 • MANDATORY for every selected applicant. Partners are also encouraged to attend.
 • Meeting will cover the special opportunity hunt rules, procedures, schedules, and answer any questions concerning the hunt.

Legal to Take:

- Antlered deer must have 3 points (≥ 1 inch in length) on a side or a main beam length of 10 inches or greater.
- Antlerless deer without antlers or antlers less than 5 inches in length (NO spotted fawns).
- Wild Hog
- Coyote

Bag Limits: (per hunter)
 • 2 antlered deer or 1 antlered and 1 antlerless (NO spotted fawns). **Harvested deer count toward FWC's 5 deer statewide annual limit per hunter. Harvested deer must be reported by the hunter in accordance with FWC requirements. No limit on wild hog or coyote**

- Hunters must stay within their drawn zone when hunting and scouting.
- Hunters must enter and exit the 7SFG (A) hunt areas through entry/exit points designated on the Hunt Zone Map.

Check Station Requirement
 • **All hunters must check in/out at the Jackson Game Check Station on their scout day and on each day of their hunt.**
